# VOCATIONAL EDUCATION TRAINING (VET) AT WHITEBRIDGE HIGH SCHOOL

Whitebridge High School provides a unique opportunity for all students to achieve dual credentialling from their high school experience.

The school offers a comprehensive range of Certificate II and Certificate III Vocational Education and Training courses which support students to achieve nationally recognised workplace credentials through school-based learning and industry work placement.

For students electing to pursue a University pathway, there is an added benefit where a Cert III credential, completed during Year 11, is recognised as an ATAR equivalent of 67. A student may then achieve a higher ATAR through the HSC pathway.
