### **2026 Kindergarten Enrolments**

If your child will turn 5 years old by the set date, we encourage you to get ready to enrol them. Please collect important documents, like your child's birth certificate, immunisation records, and proof of where you live. You can find the enrolment application form on our school website, and it should be submitted by the deadline. After we review the applications, families will be informed about the enrolment status. We can't wait to welcome our new Kindergarten students and support them as they start their journey at Ringrose Public School! Further information about our Information Evening and orientation programs will be forwarded onto families soon.



### **Family Information - Good School Attendance**

This portal allows you to view all your children in one place and respond to any recorded absences. Additionally, if you know about a planned absence in advance, such as a scheduled medical appointment, you can provide those details directly through the portal.

Please note that a daily absence notification will also be sent via SMS to remind you to provide a reason for your child's absence.

Hi all,

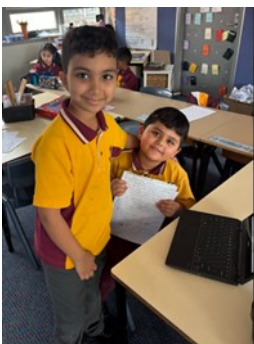
Roy Ringrose here again. I have been super excited about my upcoming visit to 2M and I was definitely right to be excited!
