Important Message to Families: Focus on Cyber Safety This Term

Throughout this term, we will provide helpful hints and tips to support your family in fostering a safe and positive online environment. We encourage you to engage in conversations with your children about their online experiences and to explore resources together.

5 Tips for Keeping Your Family Safe Online

- 1. **Start the Conversation**: Make discussing online safety a regular family practice. Encourage your child to come to you with any online issues. Introduce good online habits like respect, empathy, and resilience early on.






