Year 2 at Golden Ridge Animal Farm

On Thursday 25 September, Year 2 boarded their buses and travelled to Golden Ridge Farm in Dural. When we arrived, we sat and ate our recess, while sitting quite a few free roaming chickens joined us and were hoping they would get scraps.

After recess we split into our bus groups. 2B and 2T went to milk a cow, feed the baby goats and listen to a talk given by one of the farmers. The students then got to hold baby chicks, baby ducklings and pat a rabbit.



















2F and 2R went on a farm walk and saw lots of other farm animals. They were able to feed some of the goats, sheep, a llama and a llapaca (cross between an alpaca and a llama). Once the students fed the animals they ventured up to the paddock where they got to pat calves, goats and sheep.


