**Roselea PS Carpark Note**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As advised at the end of 2025, changes have been made to the school carpark over the holiday period restricting community access to the front carpark. These changes were made following advice from Health and Safety.

From Monday 2 February the following changes will come into effect:

- The car park that runs parallel to North Rocks Road will be for staff access only.
- The community will only have access to the end carpark that is situated between the end of the administration building and the High School.
- The carpark located at the end of the administration building will become a Support Unit and After Hours Community Carpark available at the following times

**Support Unit and After Hours Community Carpark**

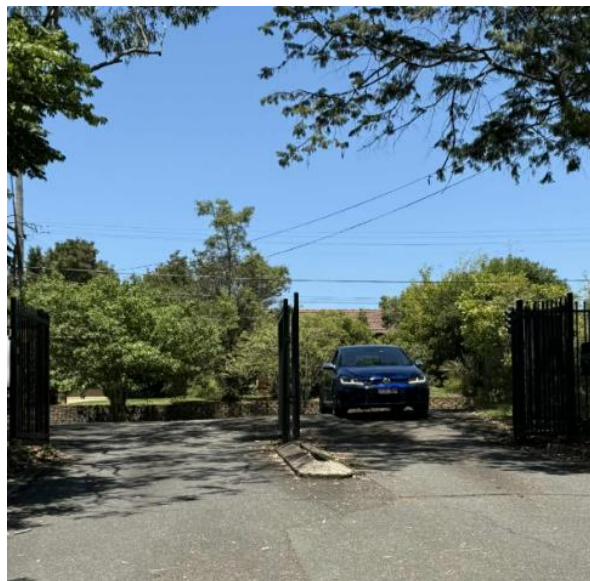
- Open to staff and support unit parents at all times
- Open to OOSH 6.00am-8.00am
- Open to OOSH and community 3.30pm-till close of grounds

**How to access the Support Unit and After Hours Community Carpark**

When accessing the carpark:

Be mindful that we share this entry/exit with Carlingford HS and traffic is both ways

Enter via the gate on the left (Highlighted yellow in the map below)





Stop at the junction between Carlingford HS (left), Roselea PS (right) and give way to any oncoming traffic



Proceed down when clear, always hugging the left. (A mirror has been installed for ease of sight)



When entering the parking area, continue to hug the left and loop under the support unit awning to turn and either a) park in the Support Unit and After Hours Community Carpark or b) exit the carpark following the red line highlighted on the map below.





When exiting, continue to hug the left and give way to any oncoming traffic before proceeding up the ramp to exit on the left. (A mirror has been installed for ease of sight)
