Thank you for supporting a fun and safe environment for all our children!

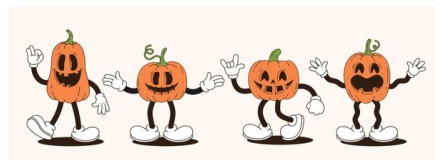
