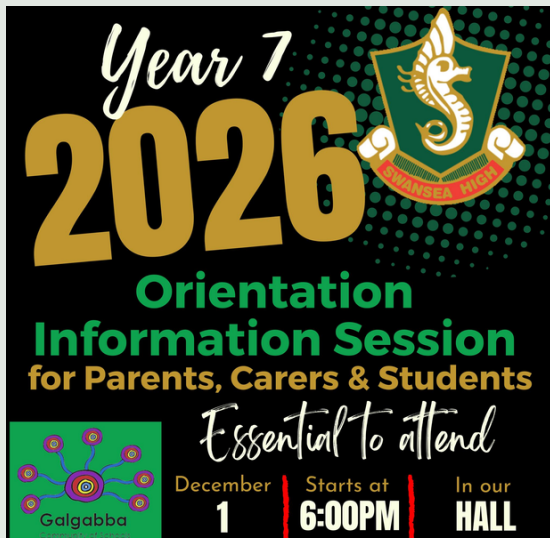

P&C AGM 2025

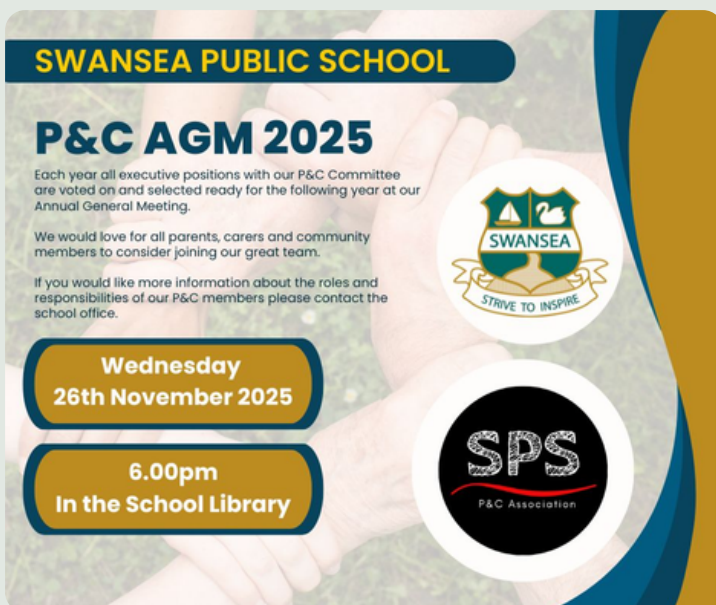
Each year all executive positions with our P&C Committee are voted on and selected ready for the following year at our Annual General Meeting.
