Clinton Free was School Captain, Turner Prizeman and School Dux in 1993. Upon leaving Sydney Tech, he earned bachelor's degrees in commerce and law at the University of New South Wales, where he received the University Medal in 1999.

Following a brief stint working at one of Australia's largest law firms, Clinton was awarded a Rhodes Scholarship in 2000. At Oxford University, he was awarded a PhD at the Saïd Business School and he was an invitee to the International Achievement Summit in Dublin in 2002. While at Oxford, Clinton also represented the University in cricket at the first-class level, playing in the 2003 Varsity Match at Lord's.

He has served on various faculties throughout the world, most recently holding positions at the Saïd School of Business, Oxford and the Queen's School of Business, Canada. Clinton has acted as consultant to a broad range of commercial firms and government bodies and authored or co-authored a number of book chapters and refereed publications in leading international journals. He is also currently a Research Fellow at the Securities Industry Research Centre of Asia-Pacific.
