Don Robertson (1958-9) worked initially after leaving school as a radio journalist, (1960 to 1965), second as a district officer with the Department of Child and Social Welfare, (1966 to 1976), third managing juvenile justice centres (1978 to 1985) and fourth, as an Associate Professor in Criminology and Policing at the University of Western Sydney (1986 to 2008). Since 2009 he has been involved in developing multi-hybrid (five sources) renewable energy-to-electricity projects for education campuses in India and Australia.

Don's post school studies spanned 35 years as a mature-aged student (1975 to 2010): BA in Criminology (University of South Africa), MA in Education (Macquarie University), Grad Dip Environmental Studies (Macquarie University) and finally a PhD (Queensland University of Technology) on the impact of international airport architecture on the management of airport security.
