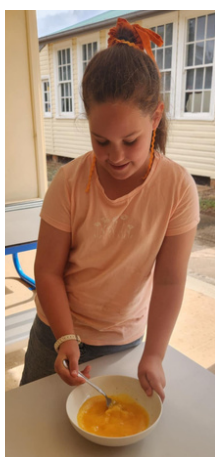


COOKING WITH NEL

LETTUCE OMELETTE

INGREDIENTS:

- Lettuce leaves
- Eggs
- Spring Onions
- Salt/Pepper
- Olive Oil

METHOD:

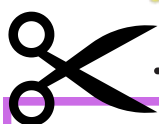
- Finely chop the lettuce leaves and spring onions.
- Whisk eggs and add to chopped lettuce and spring onions.
- Season with salt and pepper.
- Heat olive oil in large fry pan.
- Add mixture and cook on both sides for about 5 minutes.

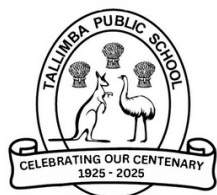
