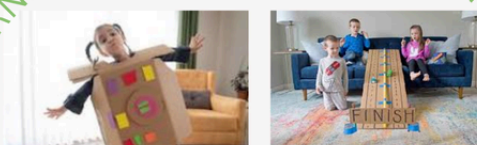

Hannah gave a shout out to **Mrs Tyack** for wearing nice earrings to school.

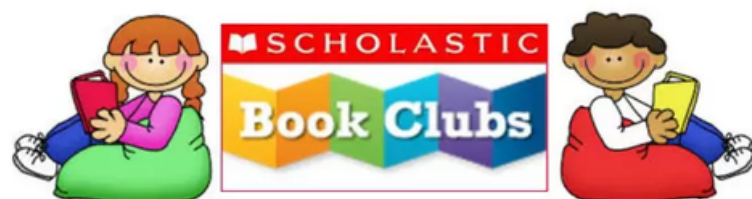
Hannah also gave a shout out to **everyone** who donated a recipe to the cook book.

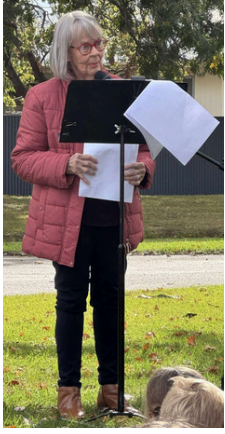
Book Club Issue 4 has been sent home with students. Orders are due to be placed online no later than Tuesday, 17th June 2025.

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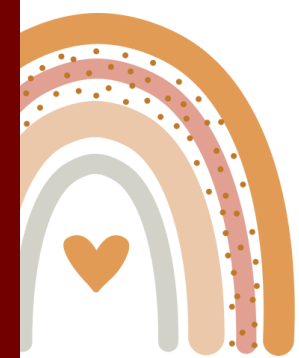
