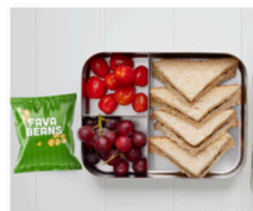
Children's Book Week is approaching. This year's celebration will run from Saturday 16 to Saturday 23 August (week 5). Our school celebration day will be confirmed shortly.
