It's wonderful to see our students engaged, active, and working together as a community across all age groups.












Paralympian visit

On Tuesday we had a visit from Jessica Macartney who is a representative for the Australian Paralympic Organisation and she introduced us to Maddie McTernan who is a Paralympian. She attended the 2020 Tokyo and the 2024 Paris Olympics.

At the Paralympics Maddie competed in 200m freestyle, 100m backstroke and 4 x mixed freestyle relay. In the mixed relay she won a silver medal. It was really interesting to hear her story. She started swimming when she was very young and would do swimming lessons 3 - 4 times a week. When she was in Yr 7 she started getting serious about it and was doing 6 - 7 lessons a week and then she got noticed by someone and that started her journey to become a Paralympian. By Bentley


