Our school values this important learning opportunity and has subsidised both the program and transport costs. Students will travel by bus to Kyogle Public School to attend the sessions.

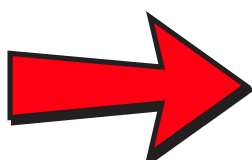
Kindergarten Orientation
