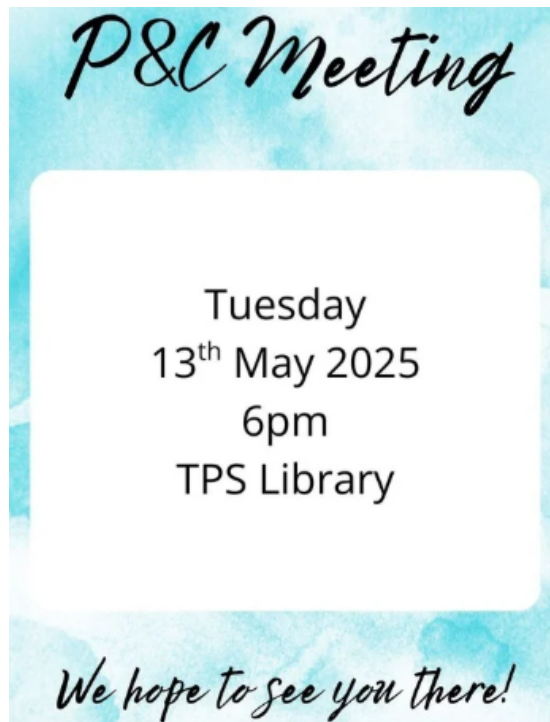
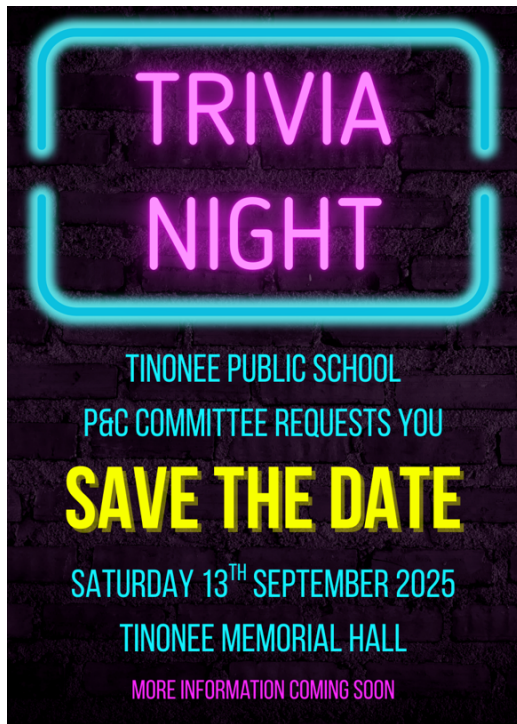
Before school reading sessions are also available for students who would like some extra time to read and update their PRC logs.

1. The Bag system- please write your child's name, class and order onto a paper bag. This bag and money then needs to be dropped into the red box located outside the Canteen by 9am.

2. Online orders at www.flexischools.com.au
After the initial registration process, you may place orders daily or in advance. A small fee does apply to each order. **Cut off time for Breakfast orders is 8am and Lunch and Recess orders 9am.**

Note: Children who require change or have ordered frozen treats or drinks will need to show their lunch bags at the canteen at lunch time to collect the rest of their order.

Part days are also available. Any time you can spare is always of great assistance!

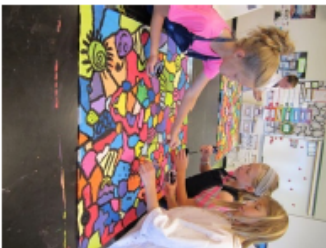
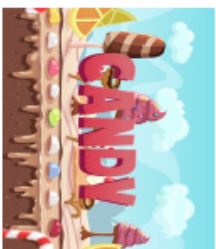

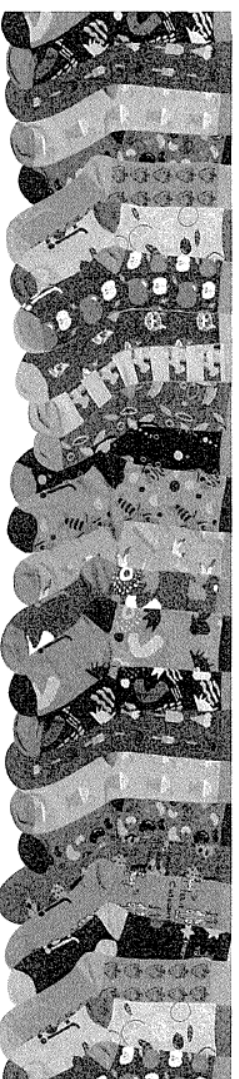
