Purpose	<p>Our Year 11 Visual Arts Camp is scheduled early in the Preliminary course to help students establish a strong foundation for their senior studies. Students will participate in a 2 night stay at Bundanon Art Centre. This intensive program provides essential skills, structured artmaking time, and opportunities for students to explore their strengths and interests as they prepare for the HSC course.</p> <p>Across three days of focused artmaking, students will immerse themselves in the local environment, work within a highly regarded art gallery and creative centre, and learn from specialist Visual Arts practitioners. This setting offers an exceptional opportunity for students to extend their practice, experiment with new techniques, and draw inspiration from professional artistic spaces.</p> <p>The artworks developed during the camp—and during a follow-up workshop at school on the Friday—will contribute to their first assessment task and form an important early component of their Body of Work. The camp also supports the development of a positive, collaborative learning environment, helping students build confidence and creative momentum as they begin their senior Visual Arts journey.</p>
