## What is happening in the 5/6 classroom..

Stage 3 has made an excellent start to Term 4, which promises to be a productive and engaging term of learning.

In English, students have begun studying the novel *Queenie in Seven Moves*. Set in the Northern Rivers area during the pandemic. The text explores themes of community, resilience and social change against the backdrop of a housing crisis. Students are already making thoughtful connections between the story and real-world events, demonstrating strong comprehension and critical thinking skills.

In Mathematics, our current focus has been on fractions, with students learning to add and subtract both mixed numbers and improper fractions. It has been pleasing to see students developing confidence in applying strategies to solve increasingly complex problems. In Geography, students are investigating how humans shape places through decision-making and are deepening their understanding of the three levels of government and their respective roles in managing our communities.

Cricket nets in the local area have been a hot topic.

5/6 and Mrs Dougherty have successfully completed the production phase of their Term 3 project, showcasing their hard work to our Infants students. Their fractured fairy tales and puppet performances were outstanding, and the audience thoroughly enjoyed the show. A brilliant effort by all involved!
