

Donation from the Sydney Visual Arts Academy





This fortnight we are focusing on forgiveness



What You Need to Know

We are currently piloting School Bytes for uniform purchases. To streamline our processes, we will gradually transition all uniform sales to the School Bytes platform by the start of the 2026 school year. We appreciate your help and cooperation as we make this smooth transition.

How to Purchase Uniforms via School Bytes

Follow these simple steps to place your order:

- 1. Log in and navigate to the Payments Tab on School Bytes.
- 2. Select Add other item.
- 3. Choose the relevant Student.
- 4. Under 'Select category,' choose New School Uniform.
- Select either Uniform Items or Accessories.
- 6. Select the size and the desired quantity from the dropdown menu.
 Be sure to click the Add button for each item before proceeding to checkout.



Our primary communication tool with parents is via the School Bytes Parent Portal and App. School Bytes includes an Absentee Form, Online Permission Forms and a News Feed. School Bytes also allows you to view your child's Academic Reports and Statement of Account. We encourage all parents and carers to download the School Bytes App via Google Play or the App Store and allow notifications.

IMPORTANT: To ensure that the registration process works smoothly and you can link your account to your child(ren), make sure that you use the same email address that you have provided to the school or if using a different email address, an SMS verification code will be sent to the mobile phone number on record for you at the school.

To set up your parent portal, follow the steps below:

- Use the QR Code to register OR Open the parent portal <u>link</u>
- Select the create a new account link.
- 3. Enter your first name as it appears on your student's profile at the school.
- 4. Enter your last name as it appears on your student's profile at the school.
- 5. Enter the email address that you use for school communication.
- Enter a password.
- 7. Confirm the password.
- Select create account.

An email will be sent to the email address nominated so that you can verify your access to the email address. Once you have created your account, log in to the School Bytes parent portal.

You can now link your account to all students in schools that use the School Bytes platform. When linking a student, the system automatically matches the data you provided with details stored on the student's school profile.

- Select link OTHER student.
- 2. Search for the school's name.
- Enter the student's first name.
- Enter the student's last name.
- Select the student's current grade.
- Enter the student's date of birth.
- Select search.

If all student information matches with parent information according to the student's official enrolment stored at the school, the system will add the student to the parent account automatically.

PLEASE NOTE - if your child's enrolment is incomplete, you will be unable to complete the set-up of School Bytes.

The School Opal card

The School Opal card gives eligible students free or discounted travel between home and school on approved metro, train, bus, ferry and light rail services during term.

Who can apply?

To be eligible for a School Opal card, students may need to live a minimum distance from their school:

Years K-2 (Infants)

There is no minimum distance.

Years 3-6 (Primary)

More than 1.6km straight line distance or at least 2.3km walking.

Years 7-12 (Secondary)

More than 2.0km straight line distance or at least 2.9km walking.



Students who live too close to be eligible for free travel may still qualify for a School Term Bus Pass. This pass offers travel on buses between home and school at a discounted rate for the whole of the school term. For more information about who can apply, visit transportnsw.info/school-students

Who needs to apply

A new application is only required if the student has not had a School Opal card before.

If the student already has a School Opal card and is changing schools, campuses or home address, their Opal card will need to be updated for the new school year before mid-December at transportnsw.info/ssts-update

How to apply

Applications for next year open at the start of Term 4 this year.

Step 1

Once the new school has confirmed the student's enrolment, complete the application at transportnsw.info/school-students

Step 2

The school endorses the application.

Step 3

Once Transport for NSW has approved the application, a School Opal card will be sent to the address provided on the application.



A parent or guardian must apply for students 15 years and under. Students 16 years and over can apply for themselves.



Which card to use

The School Opal card is only for travel to and from school. So it's a good idea to get a Child/Youth Opal card for travel after hours, on weekends or during school holidays.

Child/Youth Opal card benefits

- Concession fares across the Opal network.
- 30% fare discount on metro/train, bus and light rail services when travelling on Fridays, weekends, public holidays and outside of the peak times.
- \$1 transfer discount for every transfer between modes (metro/train, ferry, bus or light rail) as part of one journey within 60 minutes from the last tap off.
- Set auto top up and link it to a credit or debit card so there's always enough value on the card to travel.

Secondary students aged 16 and over can travel with a Child/Youth Opal card when carrying a Transport Concession Entitlement Card. To apply contact your school or institution.
