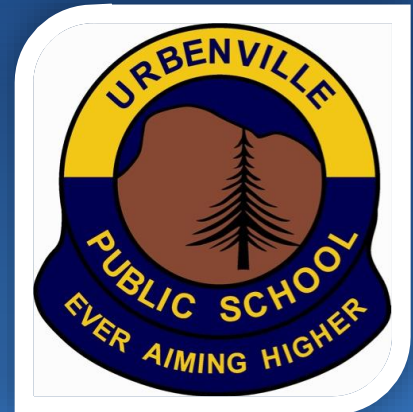

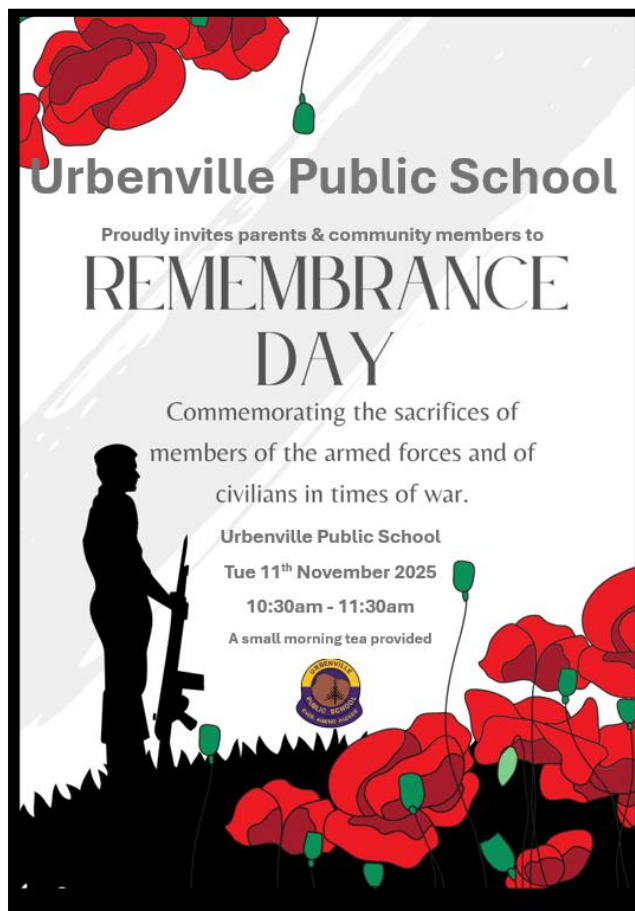

Works notification | 30 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Further to the [works notification from 19 September 2025](#) regarding the drinking water quality test results for Urbenville Public School, remediation work has been completed by a qualified and accredited tradesperson following advice provided by an independent hygienist.

Re-testing of the impacted tap outlet by an independent hygienist has returned results which meet the requirements of the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines.

Access to the bubblers on the eastern side of Building C and the tap outlets of the staffroom kitchen sink in the Building D have been restored and can be used again by students and staff.

The health and wellbeing of students, staff and the local community is our highest priority.

Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.

- responded to by relevant staff only.

- We prefer you phone or email a request, briefly explaining the issues you wish to discuss,
- or if the staff member is available at the end of the school day, have a very brief meeting. Please understand they may have other duties to attend to.

What you can expect

Our staff will:

- respond to your request within 3 school days
- discuss with you a mutually agreeable time to meet and agree on what will be discussed
- decide who is best to meet with you.
