#### Primary Parent Teacher Interviews - Tuesday 4th March, 2025

#### **Booking Information**

Parent Teacher interviews for Primary students are being held on Tuesday 4th March 2:40-5.30pm. This is a great opportunity to talk to your child's teacher, get an update on progress, and co-create goals for the remainder of the school year.

Interviews can be booked using the Sentral Parent Portal\*. If you have used the Parent Portal previously you can login with the same username and password you created last time. If you are new to the Parent Portal you will need to register to create a profile and then type in your family code to link your profile with your children. For families new this year, your code was sent home via email. If you cannot find it in your emails, please contact the school office on the email below to request your code to be resent.

You can also indicate in the Parent Portal that you do not require an interview. If all timeslots are full, you cannot make this date, or would prefer a phone call, please contact the teacher via Class Dojo message to arrange a suitable alternative time.

Please arrive early to be ready to start at the scheduled time. Please understand that teachers need to speak to many parents and must stick to the 10 minute time.

## ATTENDANCE MATTERS

ATTENDANCE MATTERS | Have you reported your student absences this week?

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral.

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unexplained on the student's record.
