SCHOOL REPORTS

This year our reports will have a slightly different look to coincide with the updated reporting policy of the Department of Education as a response to feedback from parents and carers who wanted clearer, more concise information on their child's progress.

Teachers are currently in the process of preparing student reports for Semester 1. Reports will be available for parents to view on School Bytes on Friday 20 June 2025, with parent teacher interviews to be held on Tuesday 24 June and Wednesday 25 June from 12:00pm until 3:45pm.

Parents will be able to schedule appointments via School Bytes from 4:00pm on Friday 20 June. Each appointment is a 10 minute timeslot and is for individual students. Mrs Twyford will be doing the interviews for students in Wattle, while Mrs Dawson will be conducting the interviews for students in Banksia. Interviews can be scheduled for in person or via a phone call.

STUDENT SURVEY

Every two years, the department runs a survey to provide schools with valuable feedback from students about their experiences at their school. The survey is open to students in Years 3 to 12 and covers a range of topics, including student engagement, learning experiences and wellbeing at school, and is one way in which students can have a voice about their time at school. The data can support schools in their planning, reporting and excellence. This includes helping to identify strengths and areas for improvement, assess how current initiatives are going and inform future programs.

The survey also allows the department to observe trends and shape effective policies and programs so that each student is known, valued and cared for in line with our plan for NSW Public Education.

Schools survey their students each year during the survey window in Term 2.

If parents do not want their child to complete the survey, they are welcome to fill out the opt-out consent form. A copy of the Information and Opt-Out form has been provided to parents as an attachment with this newsletter. Parents must return the form to the school by Friday 20 June if they do not wish their child to participate in the survey.

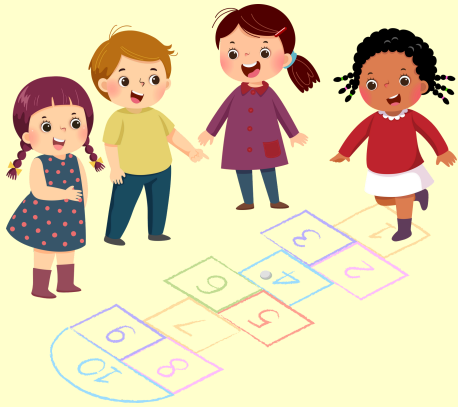
Congratulations to Sylvia, who was the recipient of the 'Student of the Week' award last week. Sylvia received an award for always being kind and helpful to everyone.

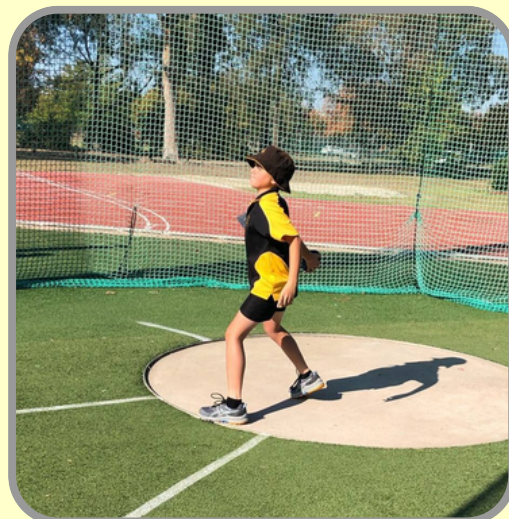
SPORTS NEWS
