Check-In Requirements:

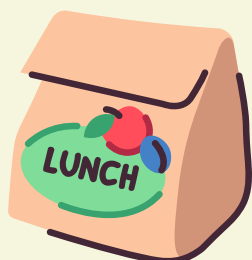
- Parent/Carer Volunteers: Complete a declaration (no Working With Children Check required) and check-in.

 - Activities include transporting students, attending overnight excursions, mentoring, and working with students with disabilities.
