

  - Activities include reading groups, sports days, supervising excursions, and joining committees.
- Special Volunteers: Need a declaration, Working With Children Check, and check-in.
  - Activities include transporting students, attending overnight excursions, mentoring, and working with students with disabilities.

The Southern Riverina Athletics Carnival took place on Friday, August 8, 2025! Seven of our talented students represented us, showcasing their hard work and dedication.


We're currently waiting to hear if they will move on to the next stage, and we'll keep you posted!


