CHANGES TO SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL AND OPPORTUNITY CLASS APPLICATIONS

The Department of Education is implementing changes to the application and placement process for both selective high schools (SHS) and opportunity classes (OC) to deliver benefits for schools, students, parents and carers.

Tests will mostly be hosted in external centres, reducing the burden on schools, and conducted on computers delivering a more engaging experience for students. We are also introducing a longer application period for parents and carers to apply. Outcomes will be released earlier.

This means that the application period for both OC and SHS is now the same and will run from 7 November 2024 to 21 February 2025. Due to the longer application period, late applications won't be accepted.

With the new application period, parents and carers can now apply for OC placement when their child is at the end of Year 3 or at the start of Year 4, and for SHS placement at the end of Year 5 or at the start of Year 6. Applications will be open from 7 November through the following application link: Selective high schools and opportunity classes

The 2025 test dates are from 2 to 4 May 2025. Students will need to attend one test date only. Students can visit <u>Selective high schools and opportunity classes – information for students</u> to access resources and to gain an understanding of the placement process, including practice tests. 

The information on the form enables the class parent coordinator to build a class contact list which is distributed to the class parent and that class only. The list will have your child's name and the names of the other children in their class as well as their Mums/Dads/ Carer's emails and contact numbers. This can be very handy as a parent to help organise birthday parties, communicate with other parents in the class, setup playdates etc.
