Morning Supervision

General Information for the start of 2025

Welcome to 2025! We have put together some general information which may be helpful to our families. When the school year begins, students will be in temporary classes for the first few days as class structures are dependent on enrolment numbers. Even small changes in enrolment numbers can mean one more or one less teacher for the school. We anticipate finalising classes early in Week 2 (week commencing 10 February), which is the first full week of school. When classes are finalised, we will communicate your child's class details to our families.

What will students need?

- Library bag these are given to students upon enrolment so all students should already have one.
- School bag, lunch box with an ice brick / gel pack and a drink bottle (for water only). Consider including fresh, non-processed foods when packing lunches, and encourage your child to pack their own bags and lunches as much as possible.
- Full school uniform see below for further details. If you have gently used uniform to donate, please send them
 in to the office. At times we provide used uniforms to families in need, and this is always appreciated.

Donations of boxes of tissues, wet wipes and paper towel for use in classrooms are appreciated at any time!

Stationery: Students in K-2 will be supplied with all stationery in the classroom. Please do not send K, Y1 or Y2 students with a pencil case. Year 3-6 students can bring stationery for personal use, packed in a medium-sized pencil case. Please note, these items are also available to use from a supply in each classroom. No student will be disadvantaged if they don't have their own stationery supplies.

- Glue stick (not runny glue)
- · 2 whiteboard markers finer tips are best
- 2 HB lead pencils good quality, eg Staedtler
- Small range (eg 10) of coloured pencils
- Small range (eg 10) of Textas- Avoid connectors as these are very distracting.
- Pens: 2 blue, 2 red
- 30cm ruler (not bendy)
- Pencil sharpener (barrel type)
- Erasei
- Scissors (short blade)
- 2 highlighters

Uniform

- ✓ Shoes: All black with black laces, preferably supportive shoes suitable for sports rather than skate shoes. This helps ensure your child's feet are supported and helps avoid foot problems later in life.
- Socks: Plain navy or black ankle socks.

All other uniform items can be purchased from our school canteen. The Uniform Shop will be open Saturday 18 January 10am-1pm and Wednesday 5 February 1pm-3pm.

These items are NOT part of the WPS uniform: Bike pants, leggings (unless under a dress), heavy boots, skate shoes, hoodies, shoes that are not all black.

Back to School Organisation: First Day is Thursday 6 February

• Kinder students' first days: To help our littlest students adjust to big school, they will have reduced hours for the first two days: Thursday 6 February- staggered start with 1pm departure. Friday 7 February: 9am-1pm. From Monday 10 February, Kinder students can arrive from 8:45am (class starts at 9am) and will stay the whole day. Kinder families have received further details including their start time on the first day. Please note, there was a

date error in the Kinder note which was posted, which read Monday 13 February rather than the correct date of Monday 10 February as the first full day for Kinder students.

- Year 1 Year 3 first day: Year 1 Year 3 are to go to the infants' silver seats when they arrive in the morning. One of our staff will gather the Year 3 students at 9am and walk them over to the Primary silver seats.
- New students in Year 1 Year 6: Arrive at the office between 9:30am-9:50am and we will walk you to your rooms.
- Year 4-Year 6 go to the primary area as usual.

School hours and departure routines: 8:30am-3:00pm

- **8:30am: supervision commences. 9:00am: classes commence. 3:00pm: End of school day.** Our Supported Learning families collect their children from 2:45pm at the Supported Learning kiss and drop on Campbell St.
- Please avoid sending your child prior to 8:30am.
- Students must arrive at school no later than 9am. Students arriving after this time are required to sign in at the office with a reason for their lateness provided by the parent / carer.
- **Kinder pick up** is from the Kinder classrooms at 3:00pm. Please be patient as we are mindful of ensuring every kinder child leaves with their parent / carer. This can take a few moments to coordinate.
- Year 1 and Year 2 pick-up is from 3pm at infants' silver seats (Mackay St gate). Any Year 1 or Year 2 students not
 collected by 3:10pm will be taken to the office. Students going to WOOSH or catching a bus will be walked to these
 locations by WPS staff.
- Students in Year 3-Year 6 are to make their own way to the bus stop or off school grounds.

For the safety of students, only Kinder parents / carers should be on school grounds beyond the office. Other parents / carers need to sign in at the office to access our school grounds, including the uniform shop.

Mobile Phones

Please be aware that no student is to use a mobile phone in a NSW Public School, other than for a medical reason, ie to monitor blood sugar levels for students who have diabetes.

Ensuring your child knows the organisation for the day should mean they do not need a mobile phone. If your child needs to contact home for any reason throughout the day or at home time, their class teacher or the office can assist with making a call. If a student brings a phone to school, they must submit this to the office on arrival and retrieve it at 3pm. Phones are not to be used at all at bus lines. Thank you for your support with this.

Parking and Safe Driving

We often see Police and Council Rangers patrolling the streets surrounding the school to ensure safe driving and parking. Please adhere to all speed limits and parking signs, for the safety of our students and to avoid costly fines.

Vital information is found in our Newsletter and sent via email. All permission notes and attendance data will appear in the SchoolBytes app, backed up by an email alert. We update our Facebook page regularly with handy reminders and lots of photos. We are a big and busy school with lots of great things happening.
