The NSW Premier's Reading Challenge is now open and Wauchope Public School is excited to be participating!

What is the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge?

The PRC is a statewide Challenge that encourages students to develop a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students and enables them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition, but a challenge to encourage each student to read, to read more, and to read more widely.

All students who complete the challenge and have their reading record validated by the school's PRC coordinator will receive a certificate signed by the Premier of NSW.

How many books do students need to read?

Students in Kindergarten to Year 2 are challenged to read or experience 30 books. 20 of these books must be from the relevant Challenge booklists, and up to 10 books can be personal choice books. Books can be read with a parent, carer, teacher or another student.

Students in Year 3 to Year 6 are challenged to read 20 books independently. At least 10 of these books must be from the relevant Challenge booklists, and up to 10 books can be personal choice books.

Books must be added to a student's online reading record by Friday 22 August 2025 in order for their reading record to be validated and receive a certificate.

How do students log their reading? Students can access the PRC's <u>Student Experience site</u> using their DoE username and password, or can log into the site via the Student Portal. A video guide explaining how to use the Student Experience site can be found <u>here</u>. If your child is not sure of their username and password please contact me for assistance.

Screens wipe kids' words

I read an article in the paper recently about a topic we are seeing more and more of every year at Wauchope public School. Children are coming to school now with a whole range of issues caused by either too much screen time for the child or too much screen time for the parents. The obvious issue is a child's behaviour when they are dependent on a device, or the device is used as a behaviour management tool basically "sit there and play that, so you don't annoy me". The less obvious one that parents may not realise is the language problems children are arriving at school with. The article said that "Aussie kids miss out on more than 1100 adult words every day – representing almost 200 conversations - because of screen time, shocking new research has found."

"Just one minute of viewing for a three-year-old was linked to a loss of seven adult words and speaking five for themselves. The research said the average three-year-olds daily screen time was two hours, 52 minutes — meant they heard 1139 fewer words, spoke 834 fewer words and had 194 less conversations every day."

The researchers say that the amount of talk and interaction children experience is viral to early language development. "A language rich home environment is critical in supporting infants and toddlers with language development.

We need to be talking to and without children as often as possible to ensure language development. Do you do these activities with your children? Read to them, listen to them read

to you and ask them questions about what they have read, sing timetables, play board games, increase their coordination by throwing a ball to them, go to the beach or pool, kick a ball to each other, eat dinner at a dinner table away from television, enrol them in a sporting team (crucial for healthy lifestyle, coordination and social skills development!).


Commonwealth Day
