Walking to and from school with your child helps to:

- reduce traffic congestion
- · lowers your carbon footprint
- encourages physical activity,
- sparks discussions about road safety.

#### Help keep your child safe by:

- always holding their hand when near traffic.
- · ditching distractions such as phones.
- explaining safe places to cross.
- pointing out potential dangers, like vehicles exiting driveways.

LOOK! Continuously check both ways.
