Extended Leave Travel

The Department of Education encourages travel during the school holidays. If travel during the school term is necessary, and you plan to take your child out of school for a period of more than 5 days, you will need to submit an "Application for Extended Leave - Travel".

Parents/carers are required to submit the completed application form, along with copies of any relevant documentation, such as airline ticket bookings and travel itineraries, to the office as soon as possible once all your travel plans are known.

The Principal will review the application, and if accepted, a Certificate of Leave will be issued, which will be displayed on the Parent Portal within School Bytes. This certificate must be taken with the student whilst on leave.

Only approved absences relating to travel will be marked as 'leave' on the roll and will contribute to your child's total absences for the year. If this process is not completed, the absence will be recorded as 'unjustified'.
