School Travel Passes

Applications are now open for 2026 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) travel.

Students living in rural and regional areas will receive their travel pass from their nominated transport operator. It may be issued via their school or be sent directly to them at home. Note: some rural and regional operators do not issue travel passes. Students/parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

Terms of Use

All students are required to comply with the <u>Student code of conduct</u>. The code of conduct aims to ensure the safety and well-being of school children and other passengers. It is important that parents ensure their child is aware of this, as failure to comply with the code of conduct can result in a suspension from travel.

2026 Class Formations

The staff at WPS will shortly begin the process of forming classes for 2026. It is crucial that we have as much information possible when we are as forming these proposed classes. If you know your personal (e.g. circumstances possibly work related) have changed and you will no longer have your child attending WPS then please let us know as soon as possible. Alternatively, if you have a child starting Kindergarten in 2026 or vou know families who are in this situation please complete and submit an enrolment form now, so your child is placed in a class. The same applies if you know of any new families who are moving to Wauchope over the school holiday period.

Student numbers at the commencement of the school year are vital and dictate our level of staffing. If you know your child won't be returning Day 1 2026 (possibly due to holiday, overseas trip or extended stay with grandparents/relatives) but you know they will be returning to WPS then I would request you let us know in writing so we can include your child in our numbers.

I invite parents to submit any special requests regarding their child's class placement for 2026 in writing addressed to myself (not the class teacher) before the end of Week 5, 14 November 2025. All requests will be taken into consideration when forming classes. However, there are no guarantees. Staff will be putting a lot of time and effort

into ensuring that all classes are as balanced as possible taking into consideration factors such as academic levels, social development, relationships, behaviour, and male/female. Please note it is not appropriate to request individual teachers.

Children Love Routine

Staying calmand being organised in the morning will help you and your child feel positive about the day ahead. It will also help you reduce stress, which is good for everyone's wellbeing. One of the best ways to stay calm and get organised is to have a morning routine for school. A routine will help your child know what's happening and remember what they need to do.

Tips to Help with Your Morning Routine

Get your child to have a bath or shower the night before, so you don't need to make time for this in the morning. Make sure your child gets to bed with plenty of time for a good nights' sleep. This will help your child wake up refreshed.

Get up 15-30 minutes earlier than you think you need to. This will give you more time in the morning.

Think about an alarm for children who find it hard to wake up or don't like getting out of bed.

Encouraging Cooperation and Good Behaviour

Tackle the morning as positively as you can. You and your child could do this by sharing one thing that you're each looking forward to during the day.

Give your child calm, clear instructions about what you want them to do, and follow up with praise as soon as they start to cooperate.

Encourage children to do more for themselves as they get older and more independent. For example, a 5-year-old can do things like putting their lunch box in their bag. An 8-year-old can get dressed on their own, make their own breakfast, and tidy up after themselves.

Cut down on distractions like television, tablets, and other devices, unless screen time is a special treat for being ready on time.

Give your child positive recognition for good behaviour rather than attention for arguing, whining or stalling

Make it fun! Perhaps play a game to encourage your child to be ready on time.
