From 10 December, you will need to be 16 or over to have an account on social media.

From 10 December, social media accounts will only be accessible for those 16 years and over. If you currently have a child on Snapchat, TikTok etc perhaps now is the time to start shutting off these accounts. We have reports of many instances of problems occurring on these platforms between students despite the current legal age for account holders being 13+. We have seen first-hand the reasons why the legal age has been raised. Unfortunately, we have spent many hours attempting to resolve issues that occurred between students while engaging with others on these platforms out of school hours.

2026 Class Formations and Enrichment Class formation

I invite parents to submit any special requests regarding their child's class placement for 2026 in writing addressed to myself (not the class teacher) before

the end of Week 5, 14 November 2026. These requests should be about student relationships both positive and negative. All requests will be taken into consideration when forming classes. However, there are no guarantees. Staff will be putting a lot of effort and time into ensuring that all classes are as balanced as possible taking into consideration factors such as academic levels, social development. relationships. behaviour, and male/female. Please note, it is not appropriate to request individual teachers. The Enrichment Class process will be underway shortly. This is a Year 5/6 class comprising students who are motivated, highly students engaged demonstrating strong capability in one or more learning areas. Students currently in Year 4 and 5 will have an email sent home outlining this process and Mrs Buczko will coordinate the assessment of nominated students and the formation of the class.

Students will be selected for the class on the basis of:

- exhibiting superior skills in Key Learning Areas, particularly Literacy and Numeracy
- teacher recommendation based on student performance
- current achievement aligned to stage outcomes
- achievement levels in NAPLAN, Check-In and PAT testing
- results from standardised aptitude testing

Consistent attendance will also be considered when forming the class. Any questions about this process can be directed to Mrs Buczko.

Stage 3 Police Visit – Keeping our kids safe





Constable Senior Steve Jeffery delivered a highly informative session to our Year 5 and 6 students on Tuesday. He covered a broad range of topics, including safety and behaviour when out and about and also online. He was impressed with how attentive all students were, and the intelligent questions they asked. Steve's big tips were:

a) Tech devices stay in the shared spaces in the house, not in bedrooms. The majority of issues he manages occur when children are given a phone/tablet and left to do what they want, without any supervision or guidance

AND

b) If you don't know someone offline, don't interact with them online. The average age of online gamers is 33 years old.

This single statistic gives us as parents and educators a lot to think about.

The Office of the eSafety Commission has brilliant resources for parents, and another online resource aimed at empowering parents to keep kids safe online that Steve recommended is ThinkUKnow.
