

Instructions on how to sync the Werrington Public School calendar to your calendar.


Detailed steps

1. Open the parent portal link – https://portal.schoolbytes.education/auth/login – and log in to your portal.



2. Select the calendar tab.

The school calendar will be displayed.



3. Select the ical button to download the ical file to your phone or device.



4. From your phone or device, open the downloaded ical.
