Thank you everyone who came and supported the Book Week assembly/Father's Day morning tea. It was a lovely morning, the students thoroughly enjoyed dressing up.


Last week, Mrs Leckie return to the classroom. Mrs Leckie will be doing a number of casual days this term. Welcome back Mrs Leckie.

Monash University HPR Team Visit



A requirement of the competition was for the rocket to fly up to 5000 ft.


They then demonstrated another launch with much smaller rocket.



Toastie Day is every Friday. We have toastie machines here at school for your child to toast their sandwich.




Hats








