The bike track has two levels of difficulty, and we will have a range of bikes, trikes and scooters, so all students can take part, no matter their skill level.

This consent needs to be provided yearly. These lessons are a valuable part of our school program as they help students learn about road safety and link closely with our PDHPE curriculum. They also help build important movement skills, focus, and self-regulation. A few reminders for our families as we begin the term:

- Our front and back gates open at 8:30 am and close at 2:55 pm each day.

Regular School Attendance

For every student to achieve their very best and stay on track with their learning, regular school attendance must be a top priority. When children are at school every day, they have the best chance to learn new skills, take part in engaging lessons, and enjoy fun activities with their friends.

As a learning community, we are committed to working together to lift our school's attendance rate, with the expectation that all students attend school at least 90% of the time. We hold high expectations for attendance because being present each day helps children build confidence, form friendships, and develop the skills they need for the future.

Every day counts, and being on time each morning is just as important. If you need support to help your child attend regularly and punctually, please speak with your child's teacher.

Our school day begins at 8:55am and ends at 2:55pm. While there may be times when an absence is unavoidable, these should be limited to genuine and justifiable reasons such as illness, unavoidable medical appointments, recognised religious holidays, or exceptional family circumstances (e.g. a funeral). When your child is absent for any part of the day, you must provide the school with a verbal or written explanation within 7 days.

DOE Mobile Phone Policy

In primary schools, the Department of Education has banned students from using mobile phones during school hours. Whilst we understand that some students may need to have a mobile phone on them on the way to and from school, any mobile phone brought to school by a student MUST be handed to the office on their arrival and collected again when they leave. Failure of students to comply with this is a clear breach of Department of Education Policy.



Flags on Fridays

Flags on Fridays will happen throughout the year which involves students meeting on certain weeks in their sports houses to do activities together. The aim of the initiative is to foster peer relationships outside of class groups, support staff in getting to know all our students and elevate the role of our House Captains. Over time, it is expected that these house groups will grow into wellbeing groups, aligning with Strategic Direction 2 in our Strategic Improvement Plan: Connect, Succeed, Thrive (a planned approach to wellbeing).

Have you checked their helmet?


Everyone is required by law to wear an approved helmet whenever they ride in a public place.





Olympics Unleashed

Nicholas Timmings, who competes in the amazing Winter Olympic sport called Skeleton, will be connecting with students in Manta Rays, Bilbies, Galahs and Goannas on Friday, 17 October, as part of Olympics Unleashed.

The students will learn from Nicholas Timmings's Olympic journey how to build resilience, the importance of setting goals and how to find what you are passionate about.

Students will hear firsthand from Nicholas Timmings about how they overcame challenges to compete in their chosen sport at the very highest level, and how some lessons they've learned in sport can help students to be the best they can be – whether that's in school, at home, on the sporting field or with friends.



Calmsley Hill City Farm Excursion

Students in Kangaroos will be heading out to Calmsley Hill City Farm on Monday, 20 October. This fun, interactive and hands-on excursion, supports their science unit. Students will explore the garden using their senses, pat farmyard animals and have a go at milking a cow. We ask that families continue to make payments towards excursion fees. Interrelate

Students in Years 5 and 6 will be participating in the Moving into the Teen Years program, run by Interrelate, which explores a range of adolescent issues and is designed specifically for this important time in their life to prepare them for puberty and for high school. At an age when talking about adolescent issues with adults can be embarrassing, Interrelate ensures it is not only informative but also an enjoyable learning experience. This program, starting on Tuesday 21 October, aligns with units in the PDHPE curriculum.

GWS Anti-Bullying Program

We are excited to have the GWS GIANTS at our school on Thursday, 23 October, delivering their 'Bye Bye Bullying' workshop. This program allows our students to explore the effects of bullying both individually and as a group.

Sporting Schools - Badminton

Our students will be taking part in Badminton this term, starting in Week 2. In this program students will develop fundamental skills like hand-eye coordination, speed, agility, and endurance along with understanding game rules and strategic gameplay. All lessons will involve a warmup, skill development and games sense activity which are modified to encourage maximum involvement and enjoyment for all participants. We know this sport will be a hit with our students!

Sydney Dance Company Matinee Performance

Selected students from Years 3-6 have been invited to attend the Sydney Dance Company's Primary School Matinee at Roslyn Packer Theatre, Walsh Bay on Tuesday, 28 October. Students will watch a one-hour contemporary dance performance and learn how dancers and artists create their work. Students will then take part in a Q&A with the performers. This excursion supports our creative arts learning by helping students explore dance as a way of expressing ideas, feelings and stories. It also connects with PDHPE, as students learn about movement, teamwork and creativity. This special experience will inspire students to explore creativity, movement, and storytelling through dance.

Our P&C will be running a colour run fundraising activity for students on Friday, 12 December. The event will conclude with a dance party!! More information will be provided closer to the event.





School Bytes Parent Portal and App

Willmot Public School uses School Bytes to assist with parent communication. School Bytes provides our school, and our families, with many benefits including:

- Instant messages to the Parent Portal (including push notifications) or via SMS message to your mobile
- Permission notes can be completed online, meaning no lost notes in school bags
- Payments for excursions and uniforms can be made online. You are also able to review past payments and Statements of Account. For some events, multiple part payments can be made allowing you to make payments when it best suits you.
- Student Absences can be explained via the Portal
- Changes to student details can done via the Portal
- View the school calendar to assist with planning for upcoming events
- Multiple email addresses per family can be setup to ensure no one misses out on important communications
- From 2024, student reports will be contained in the Portal. Printed copies will still be sent home, but parents can also access their child's report in School Bytes.
- From 2024, digital forms will be added to the Parent Portal so parents can access uniform order forms, canteen menus, change of detail forms along with many other forms.

School Bytes Parent Portal Set Up

To register for the School Bytes Parent Portal, the email you use to sign up will need to match the email address that we have on the system for you. If you are using a different email address, an SMS verification code will be sent to the mobile number that we have on record for you.

Set Up Process

1. Use the link or the QR code to register for the parent portal.

- 2. Click on 'Create a new account'.
- 3. Enter your details into the required fields and then select 'create account'

An email will be sent to the email address nominated so that you can verify your access to the email address. Once you have created your account, log in to the School Bytes parent portal.

You can now link your account to all students in schools that use the School Bytes platform. When linking a student, the system automatically matches the data you provide with details stored on the student's school profile.

4. Select 'Link other student' and search for Willmot public School in the 'School name' field. Continue entering the students details and select 'Search'.

If all student information matches with parent information according to the student's official enrolment stored at the school, the system will add the student to the parent account automatically.

 Contine adding any additional children that you have enrolled at Willmot Public School.


