It was not easy, especially adapting to feedback and trying to put my making thoughts into words for my thesis. But I was so happy with the work that came out of that year and the connections and drive that it gave me. I plan to do a masters, but not yet. I want to experience the world first. I have been accepted to an artists residency in Greece later this year and I had my first solo exhibition at an artist run initiative in Sydney earlier this year. I am always applying for studio residencies and exhibitions as the opportunities arise, I'm often unsuccessful, but that's just how it works. Right now I work full time in a management position at Petbarn. I just want to make art all the time, but at the moment working full-time in a role that allows me to support my team and earn money to support my art practice is the best thing for me to do.
