Attendance and late arrivals

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unexplained on the student's record.

Students who arrive late to school must present at the front office and a reason for their partial unattendance will be required.

Whole School Assembly Fortnightly

All students engage in weekly Library lessons with our Teacher Librarian. Please ensure your child has a library bag to borrow a book.

There are many ways that we offer learning and wellbeing support to students at Woodland Road Public School.

Support Unit

Woodland Road Public School offers a dedicated Support Unit that strives to meet the individual needs of students with disabilities. Our unit caters to students from 5-13 years of age and each class has a maximum of 7 students with a dedicated SLSO (School Learning Support Officer).

Learning and Support Team

Our Learning and Support Team (LST) oversees the support of all students across the school. This support includes academic, English as a second language, behaviour, wellbeing, attendance and engagement, and community and family support. The LST consists of dedicated LST teachers as well as a School Psychologist.

School Learning Support Officers

Our dedicated SLSOs work in and out of the classroom to support students, teachers and the community.

The library is also home to our technology lab. Students have access to devices such as Chromebooks and a dedicated Librarian delivers lessons to students on a weekly basis.

Playground and Supported Playground

Our school playground, located on the oval, is a favourite spot for students to play, explore and have fun. Our Supported Playground has a focus on sensory engagement and well-being, providing a calm and supportive area where all students

can enjoy outdoor play at their own pace.

Our Courtyard sits at the heart of the school, serving as a vibrant and welcoming space that connects all classrooms, the library, canteen, hall and office building.


