### School procedures and information

#### Communication:

#### Late arrival and early departure:

Learning begins at 8:55am each day. Students who arrive after this time need to go to the office for a late pass and be signed in before they go to class. If you need to pick up your child early from school, please report to the office to sign the student out; office staff will organise for your child to meet you there. Partial absence or lateness add up over the year and affect both learning and attendance rates: attendance rates count towards the Year 6 medallion and termly attendance reward activities.

#### Absences:

If your child is absent, it is a Department of Education requirement that you notify the school. You can do this through the Sentral Parent Portal or you can send in a note. Any leave (short, long term or part of a day) needs a letter informing the school of your child's upcoming leave prior to the period of absence as paperwork will need to be approved by the Principal. Unapproved leave will affect individual attendance rates.
