At Wyoming Public School we recognise the importance of a positive transition to school for children and their families by offering our 16-week Headstart transition program for those who reside within our intake area.

The Headstart program gives children a strong and successful start to school by establishing genuine relationships between students, families and staff. It supports the development of social skills, language and fine motor skills in a play based, fun and caring environment.

WHAT MAKES THE HEADSTART PROGRAM SO SUCCESSFUL?

- It encourages interaction, sharing, and cooperation with peers in a fun environment.
- It gives an opportunity for our staff to work closely with you, your child, and your child's preschool, allowing for a smooth and seamless start to school.
- Parents receive resources and guidance for supporting your child's development.
- Families connect with other parents for a supportive community.

Families choose to attend on either Mondays or Tuesdays. It is important to note that Headstart is not designed to replace a child's attendance at Pre-School.

THESE LITTLE THINGS WILL MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE

- Read with your child as often as possible.
- Arrange playdates and foster peer friendships.
- Sing nursery rhymes and songs.
- Create a daily routine.
- Talk with your child – discuss their day, ask them questions about the world around them, encourage them to ask you questions, retell familiar events
- Play with your child – build, imagine, explore, play board games, card games and listening games.
- Encourage drawing, the use of scissors and play dough
- Teach basic tasks like dressing and using the bathroom.
- Talk positively about school.
- Celebrate their achievements.
