How are students selected for the STEM Selective program?

Students are selected using a number of criteria:

- Results from the examination, although this is not the only criteria we rely on given students do come from different and varied previous experiences
- Participation in the STEM Selective Taster Day
- Their previous and/or future interests in STEM subjects, courses and professions
- Positive behaviour in past school reports: Respectful and Responsible
- Recommendations from their current Primary School



What should I include in my application to allow me the best chance of being accepted to the STEM Selective program?

Having all the supported information as shown at the top of the first page of the application form will allow us to easily access your capabilities or interests in gaining entrance into the STEM Selective program. Also attending and participating in the STEM Selective Taster Day.

What should I study for the STEM Selective examination?

The STEM Selective examination will consist of a series of multiple choice questions plus a short written question response. These questions are designed to measure a student's ability to problem solve, think creatively and think critically. Therefore, it is recommended that students attend the examination well rested and prepared to do their best.

What will the students be studying in the STEM Selective program?

Our STEM Selective program allows our students to have access to industry standard state-of-the-art technology and specialist teachers who extend their learning. We aim to provide our students with the skills, knowledge and the ability to achieve success in their future learning pathways. Our future focused program endeavours to produce students who are equipped with skills such as critical thinking, creative thinking, collaboration and communication within the field of STEM. This program is geared towards student interest, abilities and encompasses more complex tasks than mainstream classes.

Are STEM Selective students in the same class for all subjects?

Yes, in Year 7 and 8, all students stay in the respective classes except for TAS where they are split into different classes due to compulsory lower numbers in class.

Do I have to be within zone to be part of the STEM Selective program?

Wyong High is a STEM Selective School and therefore are able to take suitable applicants from any school throughout the Hunter/Central Coast.

Once selected, is my position in the STEM Selective program guaranteed?

No, all positions may be reviewed based on a student's efforts, achievements and/or behaviours.

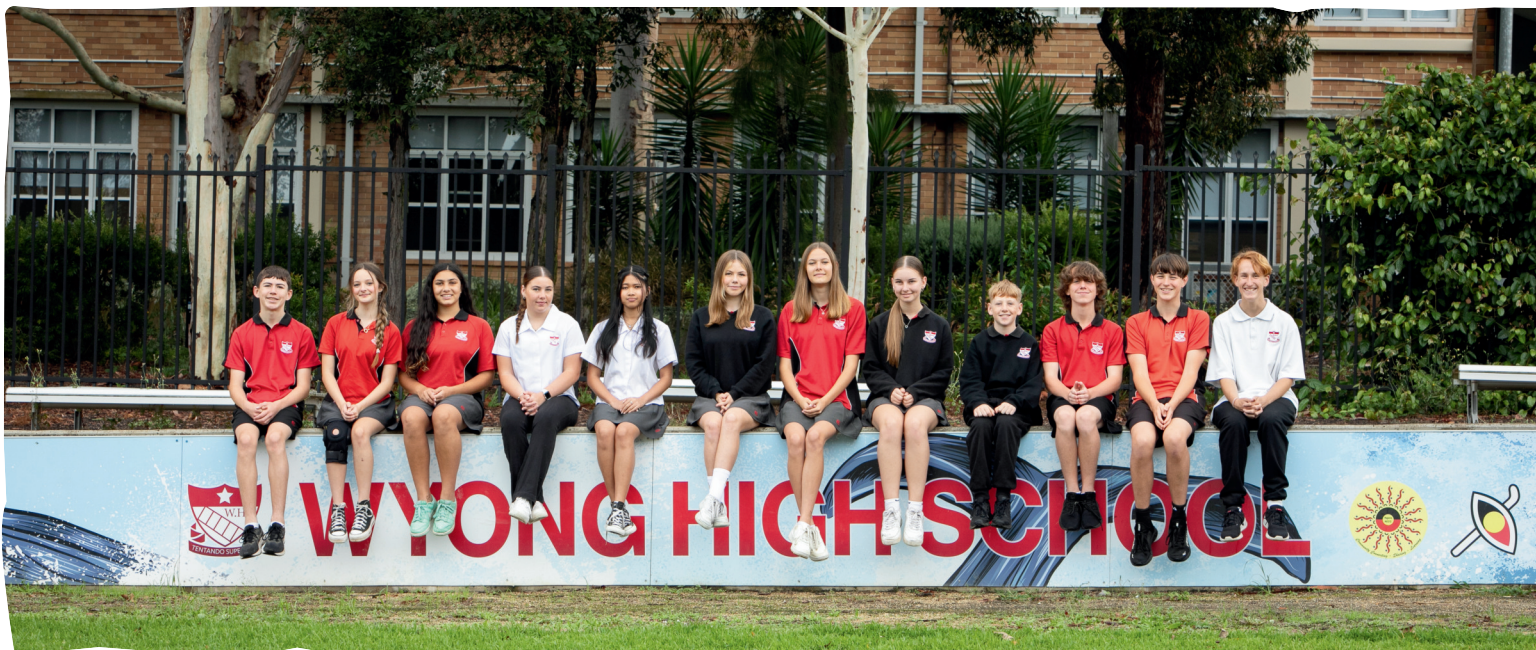
