

Year 11 Requirements

In 2026 Yass High School will be requesting that all students in years 9-12 bring their own laptop to school every day (Please see tech requirements attached).

All subjects require students to have a scientific calculator, ruler, glue stick, Blue, Black & Red pens & HB pencils, sharpener, scissors, eraser and pencil case, coloured pencils, textas.

Scientific calculators (\$25.00) and A3/A4 Visual diaries (sketch book-\$10) are available for purchase from the front office.

We ask that all books be neatly covered with the subject and name clearly marked on the front.

Alternatively, students may choose to use a folder with book inserts for each subject.

Students require full leather-enclosed footwear for all practical subjects. Please ensure that shoes meet this requirement when purchasing them.

Students are required to bring their own personal laptop computer.
