The NSW Education Parent App is an app developed and endorsed by the department, free for schools and parents and carers to use, and is synced with the School Website service (SWS)


Key features of the app for parents and carers include:

The scientists have observed the effects of mixing ingredients to make playdough.


They have discovered that materials like paper can be reused and woven into an artwork.


The scientists also pulled apart face masks to explore the different materials used and how they can be combined for a specific purpose.
