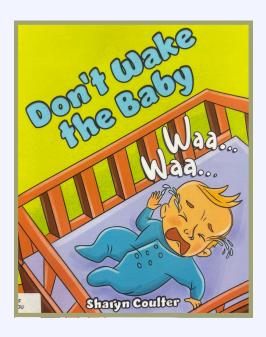
We really hope to run this event again in 2026, it was an absolute blast.
